EMERGENCY DEPT RENO BEGINS

In 2018 the renovation process began in the Emergency Department. Our \$1.3 million commitment to this project comes from previous fundraising events and activities, our current capital campaign, and a legacy donation from the estate of Mary C. Moore.

We were made aware of the need for improvement through discussions with hospital staff, and funded a feasibility study in 2015 using monies raised at our golf tournament. The reno will enhance triage and treatment spaces, increase patient and staff safety, and improve patient flow within the department.

Philanthropy is the difference between good and great healthcare. Every dollar the Lacombe Health Trust receives is put to work to serve our community's healthcare needs.

GAIT TRAINER GETTING PATIENTS BACK ON THEIR FEET

New equipment in the physiotherapy department at the Lacombe Hospital and Care Centre has been making a big impact on patient health.

"It really provides a safe, effective environment to get people walking again," says Patti Valliant, a physical therapist at the hospital. "This is a really premium piece of equipment. The biggest thing is that it provides the patient security, which protects the caregivers at the same time."



The LiteGait was purchased with funds raised at the 2018 Lacombe Hospital Charity Golf Classic. The lift portion can raise a patient from seated to a full standing position over the treadmill, which has built in sensors to monitor the patient's stride.

"When you're in a chair every day, if you don't get out of that position your bone density, your blood pressure and your circulation can be affected," says LHT Board Member Jason Lunn, who has been undergoing physical therapy at the hospital since suffering an injury in 2011. "The ability to feel an upright weight bearing sensation has been amazing."

We are proud to be able to make it possible for our hospital to provide the community with better healthcare outcomes by funding equipment like the LIteGait Trainer.
